I, by signing below, agree to the following;

- 1) The placement of any grave or lot marker is a privilege granted by the cemetery. The cemetery assumes no liability for any damage caused to the monument or marker from any source or for any damage caused by the monument or marker.
- 2) The purchaser of the monument or marker is entering into a contract with a cemetery approved monument dealer and the cemetery is not a party to this contract. The monument dealer will be responsible for delivery, the digging of the foundation and the setting of the stone.
- 3) The cemetery will charge a fee of **TWENTY FIVE CENTS (.25) A SQUARE INCH** on marker and monument base dimensions, non- refundable when this permit is presented to the Catholic Cemeteries main office, 1663 Elvis Presley Blvd. This fee covers the administrative cost of the cemetery connected with the placement of monument and markers in the cemetery.
- 4) *No work will be done in the cemetery connected to the placement of any monument or marker until this form is filed in the Catholic Cemeteries Office, the permit fee is paid and the monument design permit is filed with and approved by the cemetery staff.*
- 5) The person (s) controlling the Burial Easement in this lot or grave agree to abide by all the rules and regulations of the now and in the future.
- 6) The cemetery assumes that the person signing this permit has control of the Burial Easements. Any dispute over this control must be settled by those involved before the permit is brought to the Catholic Cemeteries Main Office. The Catholic Cemeteries will allow no stone to be placed at Calvary, Mount Calvary and All Saints if there is an ongoing dispute.
