What is an ESA?

An Education Savings Account (ESA) is a scholarship program that families with students zoned for Metro Nashville Public Schools, Memphis-Shelby County Schools, and the Achievement School District (ASD) can use to pay for nonpublic school tuition and expenses at participating schools.

- The Tennessee Department of Education will be present and available to answer questions.
