Home Parish is The Cathedral of the Immaculate Conception

Mateusz will be ordained by Bishop David P. Talley into the Diaconate within the Catholic Diocese of Memphis at The Cathedral of the Immaculate Conception on June 3. He will be assigned as a Deacon with Our Lady of Perpetual Help Catholic Church in Germantown.

Mateusz Stanisław Węgrzyn was born in Jasło, Poland on August 4, 1992. He was raised with his younger brother, Paweł, in Nowy Glinik, by Stanisław and Małgorzata Węgrzyn. Mateusz graduated from High School in 2011 and entered Congregation of Saint Michael the Archangel in Kraków, Poland.

In 2016, Mateusz left Congregation of Saint Michael the Archangel and began his work at Polish Gas Company in Jasło as a Customer Service Clerk. He also taught religious classes at Middle and Elementary Schools in Bircha, Poland.

In 2020, he came to the United States and began his studies at SS. Cyril and Methodius Seminary in Orchard Lake, Mich. He was accepted as a Seminarian for the Diocese of Memphis in 2021.

Mateusz graduated in 2022 from SS. Cyril and Methodius Seminary with Master of Arts in Theology. Currently, Mateusz is assigned to The Cathedral of the Immaculate Conception for a pastoral year and is working on a degree in Business and Administration from Christian Brothers University in Memphis.

MATEUSZ nació en Jaslo, Polonia, el 4 de Agosto de 1992. Es hijo de Stanislaw y Malgorzata Wegrzyn, y tiene un hermano menor, Pawel. Al terminar la Preparatoria, ingresa a la Congregación de San Miguel Arcángel, en Cracovia. Sale en 2016 y trabaja un tiempo para una compañía de gas, al tiempo que imparte educación religiosa. En 2020 se viene a los Estados Unidos e inicia su formación hacia el sacerdocio en el Seminario de Santos Cirilo y Metodio. Se incorpora a la Diócesis de Memphis en 2021, Mateusz concluyo su formación en 2022, y actualmente se encuentra haciendo un año de pastoral en la Catedral de la Inmaculada Concepción al tiempo que realiza estudios de Maestría en Administración de Empresas en la Universidad de Christian Brothers, aquí en Memphis. El próximo 3 de Junio se Ordenara al Diaconado Transicional, y será asignado a hacer su pastoral en la Iglesia de Nuestra Señora del Perpetuo Socorro, en Germantown.
