Kacper Wojcieszko
Home Parish is Holy Rosary Catholic Church

Kacper will be ordained by Bishop David P. Talley into the Diaconate within the Catholic Diocese of Memphis at The Cathedral of the Immaculate Conception on June 3. He will be assigned as a Deacon with St. Louis Catholic Church.

Kacper Wojcieszko was born in Lublin, Poland, on May 24, 1996, and he is the only child in the family. He earned all basic education in Poland, graduating in 2015.

Kacper’s discernment to Priesthood began when he was in 10th grade. He entered Major Seminary in Poland and after Philosophy, he decided to change his life and move to the United States. He was accepted by the Seminary in Michigan.

In January 2020, he was accepted by Bishop Talley as a Seminarian for the Diocese of Memphis. He was assigned to Holy Rosary Catholic Church, Catholic Church of the Ascension and Catholic Church of the Incarnation. For the last three years, Kacper focused his ministry on getting to know the faithful of West Tennessee.

Since Kacper came to Memphis, he considers this part of Tennessee as his second home and people as his second family.

In 2022, he was transferred to Saint Meinrad Seminary and School of Theology in Indiana. He will graduate in May 2024 with a Master of Divinity degree.

KACPER nació en Lublin, Polonia, el 24 de Mayo de 1996. Es hijo único. Empezó su discernimiento vocacional a los 10 años de edad. Ingreso al Seminario en Polonia, y al concluir sus estudios filosóficos se viene a los Estados Unidos. Se incorpora a la Diócesis de Memphis en 2020, y ha servido en las Parroquias de El Santo Rosario, La Ascensión y la Encarnación. El próximo 3 de Junio se Ordenara al Diaconado Transicional, y será asignado a hacer su pastoral en la Iglesia de San Luis.
