My Friends,


It is with great joy and appreciation that I announce the success of our United in Faith Capital Campaign. To date, 44 of our 47 parishes and missions have conducted the campaign, with the remaining 3 parishes scheduled for the fall. Redemption of the pledges will continue for the next four years, bringing much needed funds to our parishes, missions, and diocese.

To date, we have surpassed our diocesan goal of \$22 million, with our current pledge total of more than \$25 million. 24 parishes and missions have met or exceeded their individual goal and another 12 were able to achieve success in the 50% to 99% range.

I am heartened at our collective success, but I am most filled with pride at our levels of participation. Over 3,500 families made their support of the parish known through participation in leadership roles, committees, receptions and prayers.

As we look to the future, we know this campaign has set the platform to continue the mission given to us: to evangelize, to offer ongoing formation, to serve those needing pastoral care and to worship the Lord in prayer and song. And for that, I am grateful to you.


