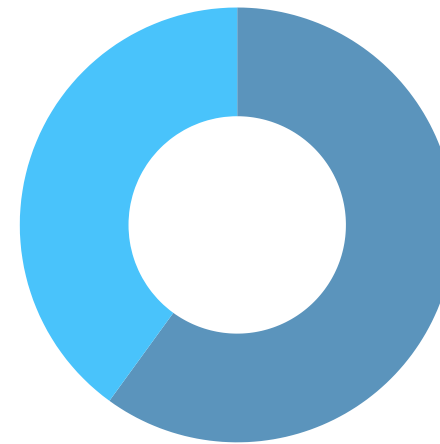

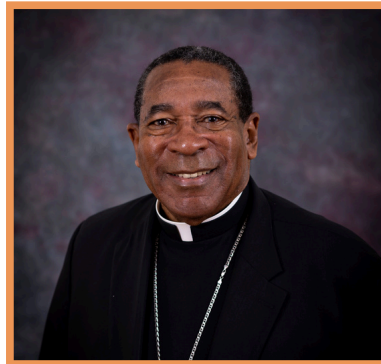

Central Deanery

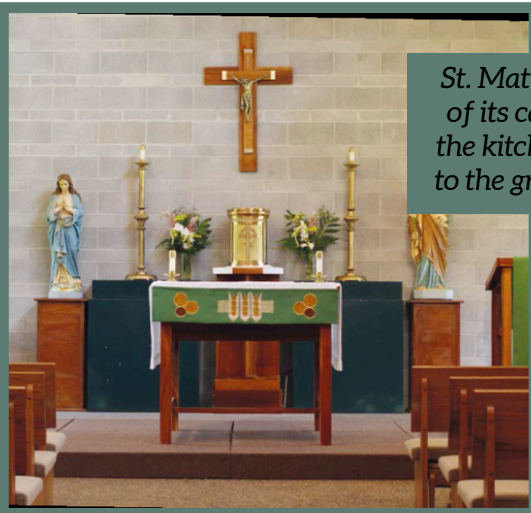
St. Francis of Assisi is currently using its funds for the renovation and beautification of the sanctuary.
